- 1. The Claim
- Jesus is explicitly and unmistakably claiming to be Israel's Messiah.
- 2. The Choice
- Jesus Forces us to make a choice:

Crown Him or Kill Him.

- 3. The Catastrophe
- No one <u>Crowns</u> Jesus over <u>Every</u> part of their Life.
- 4. The Coronation
- Jesus Crowns <u>Himself</u> King of our life by Dying in our Place.

- 5. When we know that Jesus is the King who died in our place, we will inevitably want to Grow, Praise and Serve Him. Which of these is the Lord most pressing on your heart to do today?
